It is the policy of the Board of Trustees to welcome and encourage members of the community and other interested persons to visit the College facilities. A visitor shall be defined as an individual other than a student, employee, or trustee of the District.

All visitors are subject to District rules and regulations including, but not limited to, rules of student conduct as described in Board Policy 5500.

Any person who violates this policy shall be deemed to have willfully disrupted the orderly operation of the campus and his/her consent to remain on District facilities may be withdrawn in accordance with 624.4 of the California Penal Code. Students who violate this policy may be subject to discipline as outlined in Board Policy 5500. Employees who violate this policy may be subject to the appropriate District employee discipline process.
