The Sierra College Foundation is a tax exempt, nonprofit organization incorporated under the laws of the State of California. The Foundation came into existence in 1972 and the Board of Directors has seventeen members; two from the Sierra Joint Community College District Board of Trustees.

The purpose of the Sierra College Foundation, as stated in its Articles of Incorporation and Bylaws, is “to operate exclusively to receive, hold, invest, and administer property, and to make expenditures to and for the benefit of Sierra College, thereby assisting and developing and increasing the facilities of the College for broader educational opportunities and service to students, alumni, and public by encouraging gifts of money, property, works of art, historical papers and documents, and museum specimens of educational, artistic, or historical value to Sierra College.”

It shall be the policy of the Sierra Joint Community College District Board of Trustees to support and encourage the Sierra College Foundation in its attempts to benefit the educational program.
