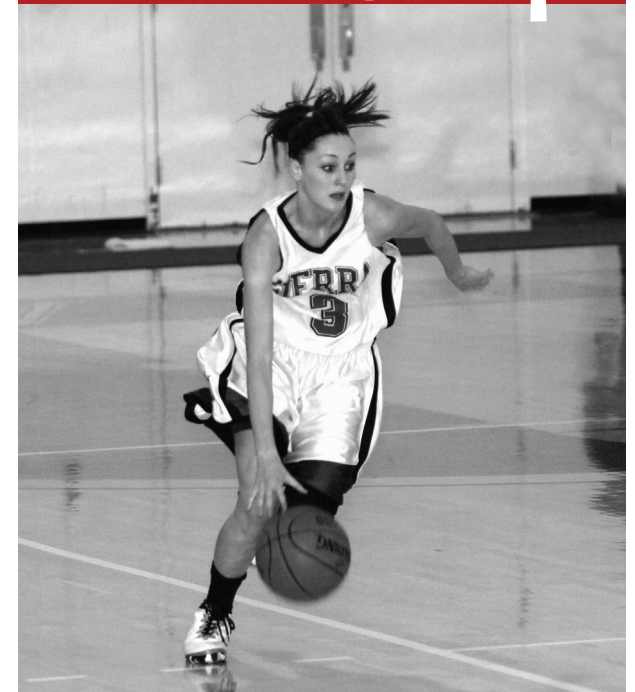

Goals

The goal of the Advanced Development Camp is to provide personalized instruction for girls on the fundamentals of basketball with an emphasis on developing shooting techniques, ball handling, passing and defensive skills. Positional skills such as post and guard offense and defense will be emphasized throughout the week.

Each day the Directors will lecture on a topic that will be reinforced with drills and videotapes. Players will have opportunities to demonstrate skills in scrimmage and game situations. Girls will be grouped by age and skill level to ensure a positive, rewarding learning experience. Camp will be limited to assure proper coach to camper ratio.
