

Directions for Submitting a Complete Application for the LVN to RN Upward Mobility Nursing Program

All applications are evaluated for the elements listed below. Ten qualified students are chosen via random selection for Spring 2010 LVN to RN Upward Mobility Nursing Class. It is very important that your application is legible and complete.

Enclose all documents in a 9 inch by 12 inch manila envelope. With the envelope in upright position, write your name, and the program for which you are applying, in the top right-hand corner.

A complete application consists of the following:

- 1. Official transcripts of all colleges attended.
- 2. Official high school transcript if meeting Math "A" requirement with high school algebra. (Two semesters of high school algebra must be completed in the last 3 years of high school with a grade "C" or higher).
- 3. Official college course descriptions for all prerequisite courses if courses taken outside of Sierra College. The course descriptions must match the year the course is taken.
- 4. Copy of American Heart Association for Healthcare Providers CPR card (front and back).
- 5. If you are using an assessment test to meet the required reading proficiency, submit a copy of the reading assessment test result from the Sierra College Assessment Center. If assessment taken elsewhere, submit copy of the Sierra College Assessment Equivalency form.
- 6. Copy of DD 214 if you are a veteran (for statistical/reporting purposes).
- 7. Enclose a self-addressed, stamped envelope as this is how you are notified of your application status
- 8. A complete, and signed, application (2 pages) for the Spring 2010 LVN to RN Upward Mobility Nursing Program.
- 9. A letter from previous/current employer on company letterhead verifying six months of clinical experience within the last 2 years in an acute care hospital, skilled or long term care facility.

Please note: If any item is missing, the application packet will not be processed. Students will receive notification of application status by mail. Notification occurs approximately 8 weeks after the submission deadline. No telephone verification is provided by the nursing department or the counseling department.

Admission into the nursing program is contingent upon a clear background check, drug screening, health screening and completion of the TEAS test with a cumulative score of 67% or higher. The TEAS test is administered once an applicant has gained provisional admission. The only TEAS score accepted is the score achieved on the TEAS test administered by the nursing program.

In accordance with Regulation 480 of the State Board of Registered Nursing, a person convicted of any offense other than a minor traffic violation, may not qualify to be licensed as a registered nurse.
