Small appliances:

- Alarm clock

- Microwave (1000 watts or less; optional)

- Ruler

Personal care items:

- Soap

Linens:

- Extra long twin sheets; 2 sets
- Extra long twin mattress pad
- Bath towels; 2
- Hand towels; 2
- Wash cloths; 2
- Pillow
- Pillow cases; 2
- Blankets; 2

For the laundry:

- Laundry hamper – collapsible or a bag
- Laundry basket
