3 Players named to Big 8 All– Conference team

Well, the holidays are here which means an end to another exciting season for the Sierra College Women's Soccer Team. The girls worked hard to finish with a winning record of 10-5-7 and a second round playoff appearance, for the second year in a row. They were one of five teams to make the postseason out of their competitive Big 8 Conference and finished 7th in the region after being recognized as one of the top ten teams in the nation. They battled against three of the Final Four competitors, which also included Big 8 rival Santa Rosa Junior College, who made it to the finals. But Sierra College was the only program to give an upset, after knocking out #8 Las Positas in sudden death penalty kicks and ending their journey toward the State Final.

Sierra College was also recognized for some standout athletes. Freshmen Kristina Stammer and Fredericka Brandt were nominated for All-American after a successful stint with the Lady Wolverines. Stammer and Brandt were solid in the midfield and backline, being dangerous in the attack and unstoppable in the backline with their hard-nosed tackles and game awareness. Both were also honored in their conference, making the Big 8 All Conference Team, along with fellow teammate and standout midfielder Alicia Segura. Segura was smart on the ball and calmed the game down to connect successfully through our midfield line.

Sierra loses 10 seniors this year, and their impact will be missed. But each athlete plans to transfer to a four year University, with some speaking to College Coaches about continuing to play at a high level.
