Jessica Parker was named to the Big 8 all Conference and Freshman forward Miani Mahannah lead the team in goals with 5 goals and 2 assists. The young women also works hard off the field by receiving an Academic Award from the NSCAA for the second straight year, the award is given to teams with a overall GPA of 3.0 and above. We look to continue toward this path of success, both on the soccer field and in the classroom as the season progresses.

1. **High Level Coaching**– Head Coach Jason Gantt is a USSF “A” and his assistants are Crystal Howard a former Santa Rosa JC assistant and holds all attacking records at Sonoma State, and Bryan Glass, a former Placer United competitive athlete.

5. **Transfer agreements**– UC Davis, Santa Cruz, Santa Barbara, San Diego, Riverside, Irvine, Merced, and CSU Sacramento, Sonoma
