One of the requirements for eligibility for Federal Financial Aid is that all applicants must show the ability to benefit (ATB) from a college education. Students who have earned a high school diploma, a GED, or a State Certificate of Proficiency are automatically determined to have the ability to benefit.

You can also show ability to benefit by one of the following:

- Earning a passing grade on an ability to benefit test.
- By satisfactorily completing six credit hours of coursework that are applicable toward a degree or certificate at Sierra College.

Once you have successfully met one of these requirements, Financial Aid can resume processing your Federal Financial Aid (FAFSA) application.
