Course Repetition

Students may repeat courses in which substandard grades (less than “C” or “NC” or equivalent) were earned. The Board has determined reasonable limitations on course repetition as described in AP 4225 titled Course Repetition.

When course repetition occurs, the permanent academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible, insuring a true and complete academic history.

Under certain circumstances, students may repeat courses in which at least a grade of “C” or equivalent was earned. The circumstances are described in the Administrative Procedures listed below.
