

**Prerequisites, Corequisites, Advisories and Limitations on Enrollment**

The Superintendent/President is authorized to establish, through the shared governance process, prerequisites, corequisites, advisories, and limitations on enrollment on recommended preparation for courses in the curriculum. All such prerequisites, corequisites, advisories, and limitations on enrollment shall be established in accordance with the standards established in Title 5. Any prerequisites, corequisites, advisories, or limitations on enrollment shall be necessary and appropriate for achieving the purpose for which they are established. The procedures shall include a way in which a prerequisite or corequisite may be challenged by a student on grounds permitted by law. Prerequisites, corequisites, advisories, and limitations on enrollment shall be identified in District publications available to students.

To accomplish the above, the Board of Trustees adopts the “Chancellor’s Office model district policy for establishing, reviewing, and challenging prerequisites, corequisites and advisories on recommended preparation and certain limitations on enrollment.”
