

Sierra College Nevada County Campus (NCC) Commencement Information RAIN PLAN

When:

Thursday, May 23, 2019 at 6 p.m.

Where:

N13 (the gymnasium).

Commencement Check-in:

Graduates should arrive by 5:30 p.m. for check-in at N12 (Multipurpose Center). Get your participation card (and gold tassel if earned) at the check-in table. You will then be directed by staff to form a processional line. Please arrive dressed in Commencement attire.

Rehearsal:

Thursday, May 23, 2019 at 9:30 a.m. in N13 (the gymnasium). Do not bring your cap and gown to rehearsal. It is highly recommended that you attend rehearsal.

Reception:

Graduates and guests are invited to attend a reception following the ceremony, hosted by Mr. William H. Duncan IV, Superintendent/President of Sierra Joint Community College District, and the Nevada County Campus Council of the Sierra College Foundation in N12 (Multipurpose Center).

Seating

Though there is no limit to the number of guests you can invite, seating is limited and we do not have reserved seating, so please ask your guests to arrive early, be seated by 5:50 and remain seated during the entire ceremony (Professional photographs will be taken during the ceremony, and there will be ample opportunities for family photos afterward).

Parking

Parking will be free on the day of Commencement. There are 7 ADA stalls in front of the N12/N13 buildings, and there is a drop-off space. Please advise your family with accessibility needs to arrive early and utilize the drop-off location outside of N12, and if possible, have a friendly or family member park the car in another location. There will be additional ADA parking in lots 7 & 8.

Honor Graduates:

Students with an overall GPA of 3.5 or higher (based on fall term grades) will be given a gold tassel at commencement. Please note that gold tassels are only given to those students who participate in the ceremony. If you qualify, your gold tassel will be given to you when you check in the evening of the ceremony.

Phi Theta Kappa:

Phi Theta Kappa Honors Stoles, Honors Tassels, Honors Cords and Key Medallions are worn by members of Phi Theta Kappa (Sierra College's chapter of Beta Mu Zeta). Membership verification is necessary for all Regalia orders. You must have your username and membership ID number to order any graduation regalia. To order, visit: www.ptk.org/Store/Graduation.
