CREATE A CONTACT FOR YOUR TRANSFER PROCESS

Whether you're interested in transferring, already applied, or were admitted to a university, meeting with a university representative is a great opportunity for you to get your transfer questions answered.

Transfer Process:

- General questions about majors

- How and when to apply
- Questions about the application process
- Next steps after being admitted

Supports Offered:

- Support programs offered (do they have programs similar to ours? EOPS, DSPS, Puente, RISE, TRiO, Umoja, Veterans, etc.)
- Support services offered (tutoring, career advising, writing centers, computer labs, mentoring programs, etc.)
- Opportunities for internships, research, and employment
- Study abroad opportunities
- Financial aid and scholarships

Personal:

- Campus life (clubs, engagement centers, activities, school culture, etc.)
- Housing options
- Child care options and resources
- Transportation options
- Campus dining options
