GENERAL EDUCATION	30 UNITS MINIMUM CSU General Education Requirements <i>(39 units total for certification)</i> OR Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) <i>(37-39 units total for certification)</i>	For most majors, it is highly recommended that students complete all general education requirements needed for the General Education Certification.

California State University (CSU) Application Priority Filing Periods

TO BE ACCEPTED FOR THE:	APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED:
FALL semester or quarter	October 1 – November 30 the previous year.
SPRING semester or quarter	August 1 – August 31 the previous year.
WINTER semester or quarter	June 1 – June 30 the previous year.
SUMMER semester or quarter	February 1 – February 28 of the same year.
Mid-year applicant admission requirements can vary. Some campuses do not accept mid-year applicants. Check campus for more information!

University of California (UC) Requirements

MINIMUM UNITS REQUIRED	60 UC-TRANSFERABLE UNITS	The 60 units includes: general education, major preparation and electives.
GENERAL EDUCATION	4 TRANSFERABLE COURSES Chosen from at least two of the following IGETC areas: Arts & Humanities Area 3 Social & Behavioral Sciences Area 4 Physical & Biological Sciences Area 5	Although completing the entire IGETC pattern is highly recommended for most majors, NOT all UC campuses or majors (some sciences & engineering) recommend or will allow you to follow IGETC. See your counselor for appropriate course selection.
CRITICAL COURSES	THE BIG THREE 2 transferable colleges course in English Composition 1 transferable college course in Mathematical Concepts and Quantitative Reasoning	All 3 courses must be completed with a grade of 'C' or better PRIOR to transfer. See your counselor for appropriate course selection and completion deadlines.
MINIMUM GPA	TO BE ELIGIBLE TO APPLY: 2.4	Requirements for non-local, non-resident or international students may differ. Please consult with a counselor for details.

University of California (UC) Application Priority Filing Periods

TO BE ACCEPTED FOR THE:	APPLICATION MUST BE RECEIVED:
FALL semester or quarter	October 1 – November 30 the previous year.
WINTER quarter/SPRING semester at UC Merced	July 1 – July 31 the previous year.
STUDENTS ARE STRONGLY ENCOURAGED TO PLAN FOR A FALL TRANSFER! UC Berkeley and UC Merced are on the semester system. All other campuses are on the quarter system. Most campuses do not accept applications for winter or spring terms.
