Which classes should I take?

Which class level should I take?

This depends on how much experience you have reading, writing, and speaking in English. Talk to a counselor to help you choose your correct level.

What is the difference between noncredit and credit classwork?

The lessons, assignments, tests, homework, and attendance requirements are the same. See information about noncredit classes versus credit classes.

When do classes meet?

In the fall semester of 2021 (August 23-December 11), most classes will be online. Students learn, complete homework, and take tests on a computer using the internet. Students decide what times they want to study and learn each week.
