



WESTERN UNDERGRADUATE EXCHANGE (WUE)

What is WUE?

The Western Undergraduate Exchange (WUE) is a tuition-savings program that allows eligible students to attend participating out-of-state public colleges and universities at a reduced tuition rate. WUE helps students expand their college options while keeping higher education more affordable. Key Benefits

- **Reduced tuition** at participating out-of-state institutions.
- **Access to a wide range of majors and campuses** across multiple universities.
- **Opportunity to attend a four-year public university** outside your home state.

Who Is Eligible?

Requirements vary by institution, but generally include:

- **Residency** in a participating WUE state or territory.
- **Meeting minimum GPA or academic standards** set by the institution.
- **Submitting your application** by the institution's priority deadline.

Participating States & Institutions

- WUE includes public colleges and universities across the western U.S. and select U.S. territories, such as California, Oregon, Washington, and Arizona.
- **Note:** Not all majors are offered at every institution.

How to Apply

- **Apply for admission** to your chosen college or university.
- **Indicate interest in WUE** on the application, if the option is available.
- **Meet all deadlines and eligibility requirements** set by the institution.
- **Accept the WUE offer** if you are admitted.

Important Things to Know

- **Selection required:** WUE is not automatic; students must meet eligibility requirements and be chosen.
- **Limited availability:** Awards may be competitive, and some programs or majors may be excluded.
- **Variable terms:** Tuition rates and renewal requirements differ by institution.
