The District Superintendent/President is authorized to operate and maintain a Residence Hall for full-time students and to fix the rates to be charged to students for residence in the Residence Halls.

The District will give preference for residence at the Residence Hall to current and former homeless students and current and former foster youth.

The District's commitment to student equity, access, and student-centered instruction supports affordable student housing. Affordable student housing supports the District's mission and supports students in achieving their educational goals.

The District is authorized to collect such security and holding deposits as may be deemed prudent, and shall manage and operate the dormitories in a fair and efficient manner.

Administrative procedures shall be developed and published regarding payment, application and admission procedures, priority placement and other information relevant to Residence Hall residents.

The District Superintendent/President is also authorized to maintain a Summer Conference Program through the Residence Hall Office. Administrative procedures shall be developed and published stating the operational guidelines for these programs.
