The District shall, to the best of its ability, employ as many students as funding permits. Funds shall be budgeted for this program in the annual budget, and the District shall participate in the Federal Work-Study Program.

Federal Work-Study Program

The Federal Work-Study Program is for students who have been determined, through the Financial Aid application process, to have financial eligibility and who are in need of earnings to pursue a course of study at Sierra College. A secondary purpose of the program is intended to broaden the range of worthwhile job opportunities for qualified students.

District Student Help Program

The purpose of the District Student Help program is to provide financial assistance and job experience for as many students as funding permits. This, in turn, provides valuable service for the District.

Procedures are implemented for the Student Employment Programs that addresses criteria for eligibility, procedures for request, supervision of student employees, and wage payment procedures.
